

SVRC FAQ Regarding Suspension Of New Member Induction And Range Status

18MAR10

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The purpose of this FAQ is to answer in one place the array of questions received concerning the suspension of new member induction by action of the SVRC Board on 11FEB10.

Q: Is SVRC accepting new members at this time?

A: No, SVRC has suspended the induction of new members until further notice.

Q: Does this mean SVRC will not again accept new members?

A: No, the suspension is until further notice, not forever. This is a suspension, not a termination.

Q: When will SVRC accept new members again?

A: Unknown as of 18MAR10. The recommendation is to keep checking the SVRC Website, where a lifting of the suspension along with details pertinent at that time will be announced.

Q: How long until SVRC accepts new members again?

A: Unknown as of 18MAR10. The recommendation is to keep checking the SVRC Website, where a lifting of the suspension along with details pertinent at that time will be announced.

Q: Can a ball-park estimate of when the suspension will be lifted be given?

A: Not as of 18MAR10.

Q: Are persons whose SVRC membership lapsed or was terminated able to bypass the suspension of induction of new members and become members again?

A: No, the suspension applies to the induction of new members and they would be new members.

Q: Are current SVRC Members allowed to renew their membership in January 2011 and each year subsequently?

A: Yes, of course.



Q: Can a family member of an SVRC Member become a member during this suspension of new member inductions?

A: No, the suspension applies to the induction of new members and they would be a new member.

Q: Is SVRC ceasing operations or disbanding?

A: No, neither.

Q: Has SVRC “lost their lease” and “has to move?”

A: No, neither. These are rumors repeated if not started on the website of another shooting club in Central Puget Sound.

Q: What is the truth about SVRC's ability to stay at their current range?

A: SVRC has been notified by our landlord that we most likely will not be able continue range operations at our current location. No suspense date has been given and a committee of the club is addressing the situation in a regular fashion. News will appear on the SVRC Website and in email to SVRC Members.

Q: Why has SVRC suspended induction of new members?

A: Two reasons, capacity and security. Our members currently number over six hundred (600) and our facility is well-used but not large. We discovered security issues requiring address and want time to do that.

Q: Is there a waiting list for people wanting to become members of SVRC?

A: Not at this time, however, inquiry email is being saved "against the day"



Q: Do Life Members of NRA get special consideration with respect to the suspension of new member inductions?

A: No, the suspension applies to the induction of new members and they would be a new member.

Q: Is there a process for gaining SVRC Membership other than the regular one which has been suspended?

A: No, there is not.

Q: Is there significant justification for SVRC suspending induction of new members until further notice?

A: Yes, please reference above: “Q: Why has SVRC suspended induction of new members?”

Q: Are there safe, well-managed places where one may shoot rifles and pistols for relaxation and recreation other than the SVRC range?

Q: How about limited membership, such as five visits for \$20?

A: The suspension was without caveat or exception.
