## SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

TIME: Monday, January 24th 1927, 8 P. M.

PURPOSE: To consider the application of the Snoqualmie Valley Rifle Club to lease certain town property for the erection of an Indoor Rifle Range..

APPLICATION: Mr. Ernest Somers, Mr. E. R. Whipp and Mr. V. L. Parker represented the Snoqualmie Valley Rifle Club. Mr. Parker presented the club's application and gave a short talk on the uses and advantages of the Range to be erected if the club could secure a lease from the town on town property.

After discussion by the Mayor and Council, it was:

Moved by Tharp, seconded by Thompson:  
 That the following resolution be passed:

SNOQUALMIE  
VALLEY RIFLE  
CLUB LEASE:

That the mayor and clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute a five-year lease on behalf of the Town of Snoqualmie permitting the Snoqualmie Valley Rifle Club to use a portion of the town property on the easterly side of the intersection of Euclid Avenue, Newton Street, Park Avenue and Park Street, known on the plat as "Landing", to erect an Indoor Rifle Range for the club, said building to be built and maintained in such a way as to be a credit to the town, said lease to be subject to such reservations as legal counsel might advise to protect the interest of the town, the consideration therefor to be one (\$1.00) dollar.

Carried by unanimous vote.
