SVRC has an expectation that in your first year of membership you will offer 6 hours of service directly to the club, whether at work parties, assist with renewal paperwork, range improvement, or other ways to help out.

I hereby apply for membership in the Snoqualmie Valley Rifle Club with full understanding that I must be a current member in good standing of the National Rifle Association of America. With this application, I pledge to participate in club activities or meetings or work parties. I understand that further rules with respect to volunteering my time to benefit SVRC may be published from time to time by the Board of Directors, and I agree to abide by these rules.

I further pledge that I am a citizen of the United States, not a member of any group which has as one of its purposes the overthrow by force or violence the government of the United States, and, if admitted to membership, will fulfill the obligations of good stewardship of the land, good sportsmanship, and good citizenship. I certify that no past or present legal action affects my ability to lawfully handle or possess firearms.

Firearms Handling Rules

These are basic firearm safety rules. SVRC range safety rules are more comprehensive. When you have read each numbered item below, initial to show that you understand what it says, and agree to abide by it.

1. _____ All firearms are always to be treated as loaded! They must be handled with due care and caution.

2. _____ Do not bring a loaded firearm from your car to the firing line.

3. _____ Keep your finger off of the trigger until your sights are on the target.

4. _____ Be aware of where your muzzle is pointed at all times, and never point your gun at anything you are not willing to shoot.
5. _____ Be sure of YOUR TARGET, and what is behind and beyond your target.
6. _____ Eye and Ear Protection is required for shooters and spectators while on the firing line and anywhere in the shooting shed.
7. _____ No alcohol or illegal substances allowed.
8. _____ Absolutely no handling of firearms allowed during a cease fire. During a cease fire all firearms must be in a safe condition, chambers empty, actions open, magazines out, rifles in rifle racks and handguns cased.
9. _____ Know how to use your firearm safely. Seek help if you need it.
10. _____ The Snoqualmie Valley Rifle Club (SVRC) Executive Officer, and all other Officers & Directors have authority over the handling and discharge of firearms, and the conduct of all persons on the premises. Failure to abide by these rules, and/or abide by any SAFETY-related commands issued by anyone on the range may result in your being escorted from the premises.
11. _____ SVRC does not have a resident rangemaster. Any member can request a cease fire and any member can, and is expected to, call a cease fire in the event of a safety violation, an emergency, people or animals on the range.
12. _____ You must coordinate with other shooters on the firing line before calling a cease fire and prior to stepping beyond the front edge of the shooting line. If a cease fire is called you must stop shooting and clear your firearm as in item 8. If you are on the rifle range, the pistol range must also observe a cease fire.
13. _____ SVRC is a members only club. You must be a member or a guest of a member who is present to shoot here. Members who bring a guest are responsible for that guest's conduct and adherence to safety rules. This means being right with the guest until the member is completely satisfied the guest understands the safety rules.
14. _____ It is your responsibility to ensure that every round fired impacts the berm. Deliberately or repeatedly firing so that your bullets do not impact the backstop may result in your ejection from the premises. Use only paper targets attached to target boards or plastic bottles. (do not shoot target board supports, targets must be on target boards only)
15. _____ Only persons over 18 years of age may use the range without immediate supervision of a responsible adult acting with parental consent. All Handgun users must be 21 years of age or older, or under the immediate supervision of a responsible adult with parental consent.
16. _____ SVRC is a cold range. Firearms are to be unloaded and in a safe condition while being carried to and from vehicles. Pistols are not to be carried loaded in holsters (except Law Enforcement or by approval of Executive Officer). Drawing from the holster is prohibited except by approval of Executive Officer
17. _____ Action shooting ranges on back part of range are only to be utilized by safety approved competitors (e.g. IPSC, Cowboy Action, & Law Enforcement) In order to be approved for this part of the facility you must be involved with one of these disciplines and undergo an additional safety class given by the Discipline Chair.
18. _____ Posted shooting times must be adhered to.
19. _____ All new members must attend a formal range safety briefing given at the range prior to being allowed to shoot without supervision.

I understand that firearms are potentially hazardous objects which can cause serious injury or death if misused. I agree that I will assume full financial responsibility for any injuries, losses, or damages resultant from my misuse or careless handling of any firearm. I agree to defend, release, indemnify and hold harmless Snoqualmie Valley Rifle Club against any claims made by me, my estate, or my agents unless it can be demonstrated that Snoqualmie Valley Rifle Club acted in gross negligence or with deliberate intent to cause harm.

I understand that I must bring this application in completed form minus signature plus valid picture identification to a Board of Directors meeting and present it to an Officer or other Board Member with any accompanying documents. Once my application has been accepted as being in proper order and I have paid dues, then I may take a range safety orientation class taught by the Executive Officer or his designee, and then may use the range without further supervision.
